**How to Attract and Retain a Great Team:** "We do team activities outside the office. Next month we plan on hiking in Mount Baker National Park."

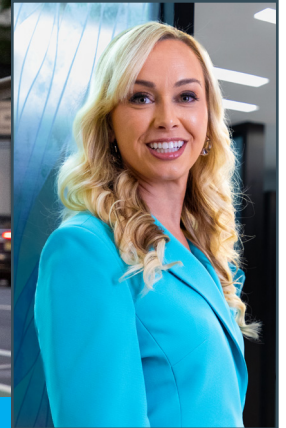
